- a. Fundraiser Request Process & Leadership Board Role (Robin)
 - Will require 2 months leadway for office prep and advertising.
- b. January Financials & February Outlook (Jason).
 - January had a deficit of \$4700. Suspect weather caused delay in start of normal giving.
 - Saw building fund donations begin in January.
 - Question was asked about cost of copier. Pastor Jim will provide information via email.
 - Question on exterminator cost. Jason will provide information via email.

- a. Discussion on Hymnals.
- b. Issue with backflow from city inspections.

- c. Kevin working on deeds associated with Church & cemetery.
- d. Mower getting maintenance.
- e. Mulch needs to be purchased for islands.
- f. Painting for inside locations and for new concrete entrance curbing will be done soon.
- g. Question The \$6500 left budgeted for projectors. Can it be put toward concrete work? After discussion, the Board was not interested in this action.
- h. Question on projectors Would an LED wall unit be better than a new projector? It was explained that a new projector would be far less expensive, and the new projectors would provide a better image than the current projectors. Estimates to come on the projectors.

Old Business

Approval of February Minutes. Motion made to approve. Passed.

Taskforce Updates

- a. Church Structure (Robin, Mike, Jay, Pastor Jim. This task force met and Q&A's were provided for review. After discussion, it was proposed to have two Q&A sessions on April 8th and to have a congregation vote on April 10th at 7pm following the community dinner. It was agreed to present 15 members to be on the Board if it is approved by the congregation to go to the Simplified version. Motion made and seconded to approve. Passed unanimously.
- Inclement Weather Policy (Bev, Jarrod, Pastor Jim). This task force took examples from other churches and documented the policies for handling weather related conditions.
 Motion made and seconded to approve the new Inclement Weather Policy as distributed. Passed unanimously.
- c. Security Grant (Bev). Bruce Willson provided details and advised that currently there are too many gaps in the process for us to try for a grant now. Suggested the Board take action to do a risk assessment. It was recommended that we do a risk assessment.
 Motion made and seconded to approve. Passed unanimously.

New Business
