## **Cornerstone Community Ministries**

**Cornerstone Food Pantry** - Groceries are distributed every Wednesday to St. Charles County families. Our food pantry also distributes back-to-school supplies, Thanksgiving dinners and Adopt-a-Family gifts at Christmas, along with a mitten tree.

**Dewey Wofford Memorial** - New athletic shoes are purchased to help athletes from Fort Zumwalt North, and their siblings, who cannot afford them.

**Eggstravaganza for children with Disabilities** - We offer volunteer assistance to the St. Charles Police and Park & Recreations Department during the Egg Hunt for children with special needs.

**Epworth Drop In** - Volunteers prepare lunch on the 4th Monday of the month for kids (late teens & early 20's) that come to the center.

**FAST:** St. Charles Foster Care (FAST) is an organization supporting foster parents in St. Charles County. FAST needs help because of the increasing influx of drugs affecting pregnant young women and their babies.

**Festival of Sharing** - Quilts for auction, Heifer Project and various kits donated by church families.

**Mozambique** - Support of the Missouri Conf. mission to Mozambique with financial assistance and communication with our sister church, Central UMC in the Funhalouro District.

**Personal Energy Transportation (PET)** - Fabrication of wooden parts for PETS (personal energy transportation) by United Methodist Men.

**Pharr Mission Team** - One week mission trip to Pharr, Texas to build additions or repair existing homes.

**Habitat for Humanity** - Participation in United Methodist coalition to build one house a year in St. Charles County.

**OASIS** - Support for large St. Charles County food pantry by distributing groceries the third Saturday of the month and stocking shelves.

**Operation Backpack** - Provides backpacks with food & snacks every weekend during the school year, to students of families in need, at 3 local elementary schools.

**Shoeman Water Projects** - Used shoes are donated to fund wells in Third World countries.
